THE CHALLENGE

Pick your favorite historic building or site in Queens. If you need some ideas, refer to a list of Queens Landmarks or monuments. Visit the site, or use reference pictures to get a good look at it, and draw it out. While visiting or researching it, examine the sites history, and consider what it means to you.

IDEAS INCLUDE

Post Office, Library, Church, Statue, Temple, Mosque, Park, Cemetery.

CONTEST RULES

Draw the building or site of your choice on a separate piece of paper (8.5"x11").

You may use pencils, colored pencils, crayons or watercolors.

Write at least one paragraph stating the name of the place you drew, its history, and the reason you picked it, then paper clip it to the back of your drawing. Make sure to use your school heading!

Please note that your work becomes the property of the Queens Historical Society, and enters our collections.

- ² Your paragraph or essay with the school heading.
- ³ Completed **ENTRY FORM** glued or taped to the back of your drawing.
- ⁴ Give your drawing, the essay and \$1 processing fee paper clipped together, to your teacher.
